1. Purpose of the report

To request a waste bin in the area between the bottom and top of the steps in Hobbes Close due to a consistent amount of rubbish being left on the steps and along that pathway.

2. **Background**

Hobbes Close, is just of Burnham Road and St Aldhelm's Road, it was constructed on two levels with a path connecting them, which then joined up to Park Road via a set of steps. This path is used by a lot of people to go from one level of Hobbes Close to the other, also many children / young adults use it as a cut through to go to and from schools.

It has had a problem with rubbish being disposed of along that path for a while now. Residents in the area and others who walk this path /steps have complained about it being an eyesore, and wondered if the Town Council would kindly supply a bin in a suitable place along this path to help contain the amount of rubbish being thrown away there. It will hopefully encourage the children / young adults to place their unwanted wrappers/ drink bottles in a bin.

3. Proposal

That a bin will be sited in the proposed location, and for it to be arranged to go onto the regularly collection cycle.

4. Risks / Financial Cost.

Financial costs are purchasing a new bin and siting of said bin, unless one can be relocated from another area. Also, the cost of collection and disposing of the rubbish.
