Response from Wiltshire Council to bin request (meeting 18th September)

1. <u>Purpose of the report</u>

1.1 To provide the Committee with a background of issues with bins & littering in Malmesbury.

2. <u>Background</u>

- 2.1 P&E received a report on the 18th September detailing proposals to improve the littering situation in Malmesbury.
- 2.2 Proposals were subsequently put to Wiltshire Council which included;
 - To change all red dog waste bins to show they are also for general waste now.
 - To note that there are few bins within the Reeds Farm estate and seemingly no bins on the new Filands estate.
 - To relocate one of the bins at Cuckingstool Mead, as having two opposite each other seems impractical to the entrance of the Filands development.
 - To relocate one of the bins on Alexander road to junction of Pool Gastons road/Bremilham road.
 - To relocate one of the bins on Corn Gastons to the steps connecting Hobbes close to Park road.
 - To Relocate one bin at the top of Bonners Close to the junction of Snell Avenue and Wheeler Way on the Filands estate.
 - To note that there are two bins on a single post at the top of Twynnoy close, which could be changed for a single bigger bin so freeing up two more for relocation.
 - To note that future building developments will need suitable waste collection bins within the developments.
 - To find out who is responsible for the emptying of the bin outside MVFC, as it is not on either of the maps given to me.

3. Financial implications



- 3.1 Wiltshire council can supply & fit illustrated bins for £100 each.
- 3.2 Any new bins purchased would need to be emptied by Idverde at a cost to MTC that would need to be identified.

4. <u>Proposal</u>

4.1 Members of the Committee determine whether to progress with the proposals having received the response from Wiltshire Council
