## a. Planning Applications received since previous meeting

#### 19/10825/TPO – Westhill House, SN16 0AX

It was resolved that the P&E Committee has **no objection** to this application subject to the views of the Tree Warden

## 19/10435/FUL - 16 Gastons Road, SN16 0BE

It was resolved that the P&E Committee has **no objection** to this application.

#### 19/10702/FUL - Land adjacent to Waitrose

It was resolved that the P&E Committee **strongly objects** to this application, the main issues being;

- There was no reason or justification for the application being made
- The site is within the Conservation Area
- The application site is not designated for development in the Malmesbury Neighbourhood Plan
- Other proposed features have no reason to be included such as; (a) the plan for levelling / infilling
  of the hillside just behind the gabion wall, and (b) the plan for a 4m-wide gravel path, complete
  with entrance gate, running down the hill on the southern side of the site
- It is impossible accurately to judge the height of the proposed gabion wall
- Biodiversity and geological conservation
- A Full Tree Survey should be conducted
- The EA should be invited to comment on the application given its close proximity to the River Avon

#### PE/92 To receive final report for locations of bins from Wiltshire Council

# PE/93 To discuss and determine course of action for Highways Improvements Requests to address speeding issues on Tetbury Hill & issues at Baskerville (under by-pass bridge)

It was resolved to contact the resident who had raised the issue at Tetbury Hill and to forward a copy of the Traffic Survey that had been completed in 2018. Members agreed that the survey had not highlighted any alarming trends but that the situation will be monitored.

It was resolved that the issues raised at Baskerville were noted and will be deferred to a later meeting as further information is required.

It was resolved that the Clerk will contact businesses which had made the complaint to explain that MTC is not in a position to contest the decision made by Wiltshire Council to bring charges in Malmesbury into line with other Market Towns in the county but that the Council recognises the importance of parking in the town and will continue to support the two hour free parking subsidy.
