Relocation of Bin at Filands

- 1. <u>Purpose of the report</u>
- 1.1 To seek guidance from the committee regarding the relocation of a bin at Filands Park
- 2. <u>Background</u>
- 2.1 Following concerns raised by residents about the hazardous positioning of a bin at Filands Park and requesting its potential relocation, for safety reasons. Wiltshire Council were contacted and asked to move the bin. They agreed, but as they didn't consider the bin to be in a dangerous position, (despite one child crashing in to it whilst riding a bike), they said they would charge in the region of £190 to move it.
- 3. <u>Proposal</u>
- 3.1 The committee are asked to consider whether they would want to assess the potential hazard for themselves to determine:
 - a) whether they should approach Wiltshire Council again requesting resiting of the bin at no cost on the grounds of safety; or,
 - b)Agree to move the bin and pay the fee for its relocation to a safer spot
