#### ***Deacon & Garratt Two Lives in Colour***

*Paul Deacon & Chris Garratt*

*Often, when looking at a painting - a Titian, for instance, or a Monet, maybe a Matisse, our reaction is "I love the colours..." - a perceptual response which precedes any concern with the subject matter. Similarly, at the heart of the English love affair with gardening, from flower beds to flower shows, is the visual pleasure we take in the displays of vibrant colours: "A rose by any other name..." (OK, that's primarily about its scent but...). The common element in this exhibition of contrasting paintings by Paul Deacon and Chris Garratt is the celebration of colour - its emotional charge, its natural phenomena as reflected, refracted light.*

*Paul and Chris met at Bath Academy of Art, Corsham way back in the 1960's, and have remained lifelong friends throughout their respective diverse careers in painting, film, music and teaching. At Corsham, Chris and Paul were strongly influenced by the rigorous, uncompromising teaching of their tutor, Howard Hodgkin. Hodgkin's language of colour and his legendary lengthy deliberations over its application in his own paintings is often misunderstood by critics as the decorative antics of a*

*"great colourist" (a term that he himself despised). The relevance of his own high standards of artistic validity, transferred into his teaching, has remained with Paul and Chris throughout their divergent careers.*
